



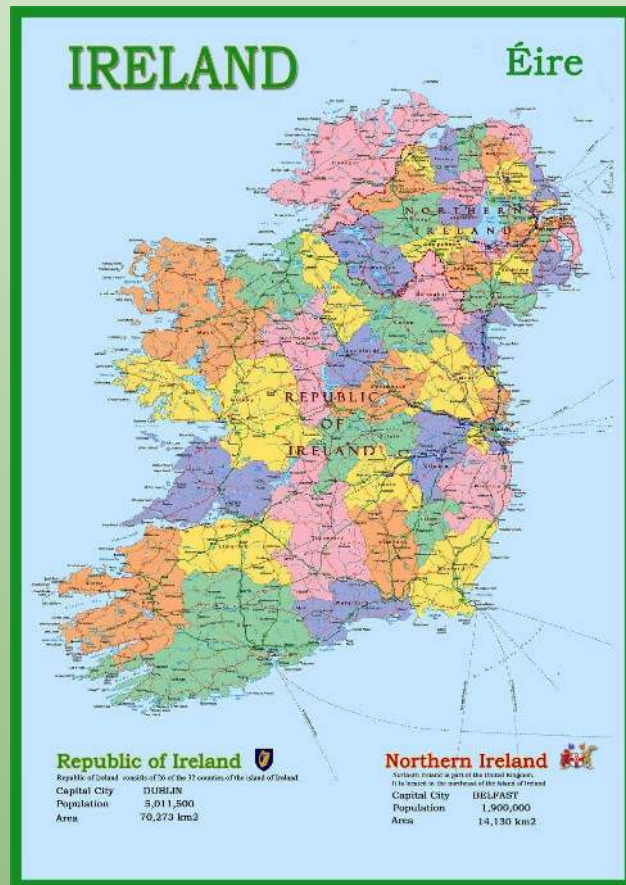
History of the LAOH
